Classroom News

Science- in Science we are continuing to study the scientific process. Students will be learning each step and what happens throughout to complete the process. On Wednesday for Science we are having a speaker from the Health Department that is coming in to do a presentation on oral hygiene. The students will get a lot of information as well as a toothbrush and tablets that show plaque on your teeth.

ELA- With it being a 3 day week for students we are not going to begin a new lesson this week. I will be introducing two of our reading computer programs to the students: Accelerated Reader (AR) and Compass Learning Odyssey. Students will use these programs at school on a weekly basis and I want to get them familiarized with logging on and the setup of the website. Students will also be spending a lot of time reading silently, reading with a partner and writing journal entries.
